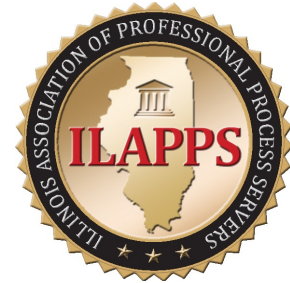

MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY:

MEASURES OF LAW AND LEGISLATION:

The topic of continued education for process servers in Illinois has been an on-going agenda since discussions began at the suggestion of President Tom Denton during the 2017 Annual Conference and Membership Meeting.

Through a series of meetings the board agreed to discuss continued education with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR). The IDFPR already has a statutory right to adopt continued education Rules in the Administrative Code, which already governs training and other guidelines for professionals in Illinois.

President Tom Denton, created the Special Committee on Continued Education that was tasked with creating a proposal to include reasonable continued education hours and guidelines to be approved by the ILAPPS Board. Fred Zakula, At-Large Director of ILAPPS Board was appointed to Chair the committee. The Chair invited members from the Associated Detectives and Security Services of Illinois (ADSAI) and other professionals in the industry to join the committee.

It came to the attention of ILAPPS that SB2462 had been filed with the General Assembly on January 31, 2018. The bill contained continuing education provisions for Private Detectives and Process Servers. This legislative measure has since been postponed and will not progress through the Illinois General Assembly. In line with the original agreed upon action by the ILAPPS Board, the Special Committee on Continued Educations will pursue further continued education discussions with IDFPR rather than forcing the issue through legislation. Currently discussions with the IDFPR are expected to begin with the departments legislative liaison, John Webb.
