LEGISLATIVE ANNOUNCEMENT

Please review the full text documents provided within this correspondence concerning a legislative measure that has been filed as Senate Bill 2462, regarding continued education for Illinois Process Servers and Private Detectives.



As discussed in previous correspondence to ILAPPS Members in Good Standing, (President's Letter and Newsletter Vol. 3 No. 3), an agenda to help shape continued education in Illinois has been the subject of discussions among professionals in this industry. Since the 2017 ILAPPS Annual Conference and Membership Meeting the ILAPPS Board and the ILAPPS Special Committee on Continued Education has been working with ADSAI and other professionals to propose a reasonable guide for continued education in hopes to secure and promote professionalism.

On Jan. 30, 2018 Senate Bill 2462 was filed with the Illinois General Assembly by ADSAI Lobbyist, John Carr. The Chief Sponsor is Senator Tony Munoz and on this date the measure was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Assignments.

On Feb. 7, 2018 the bill was assigned to Committee on Licensed Activities and Pensions.

On Feb. 15th, this assignment was postponed and a committee hearing scheduled for Feb. 21st at 1:30 in the Capitol Room 400.

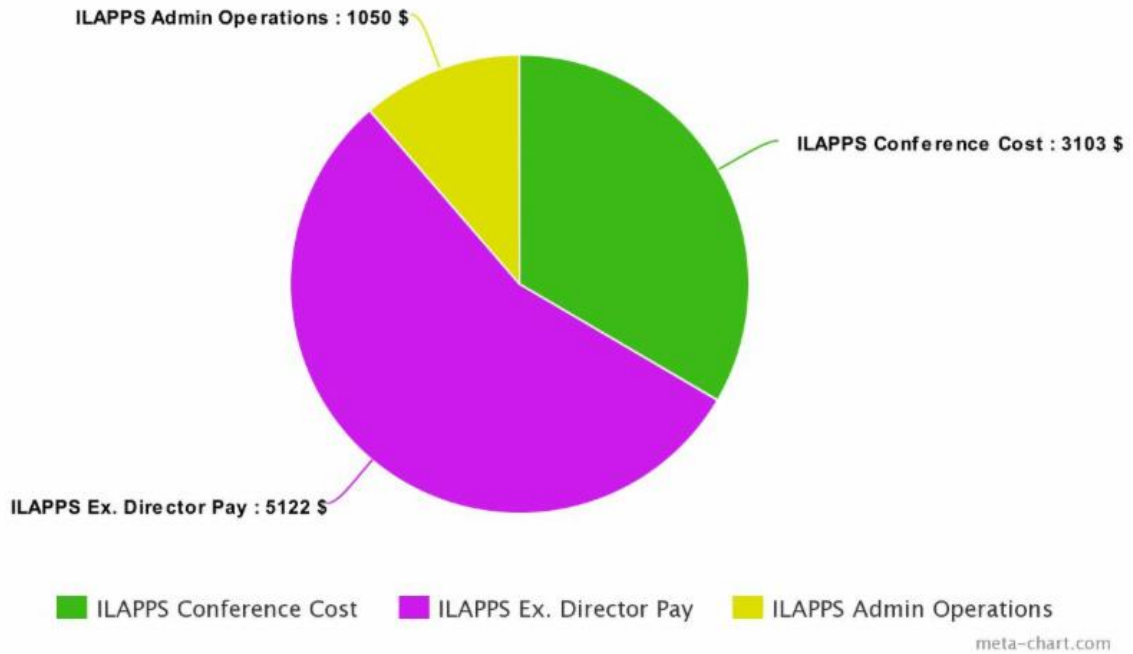
Likewise, if you are submitting a check for a general donation please note that you want your contribution to be applied as a general donation.

ILAPPS is a 501(C)(6) non profit. Contributions made to a legislative cause are set aside for those purposes and may not be tax exempt.

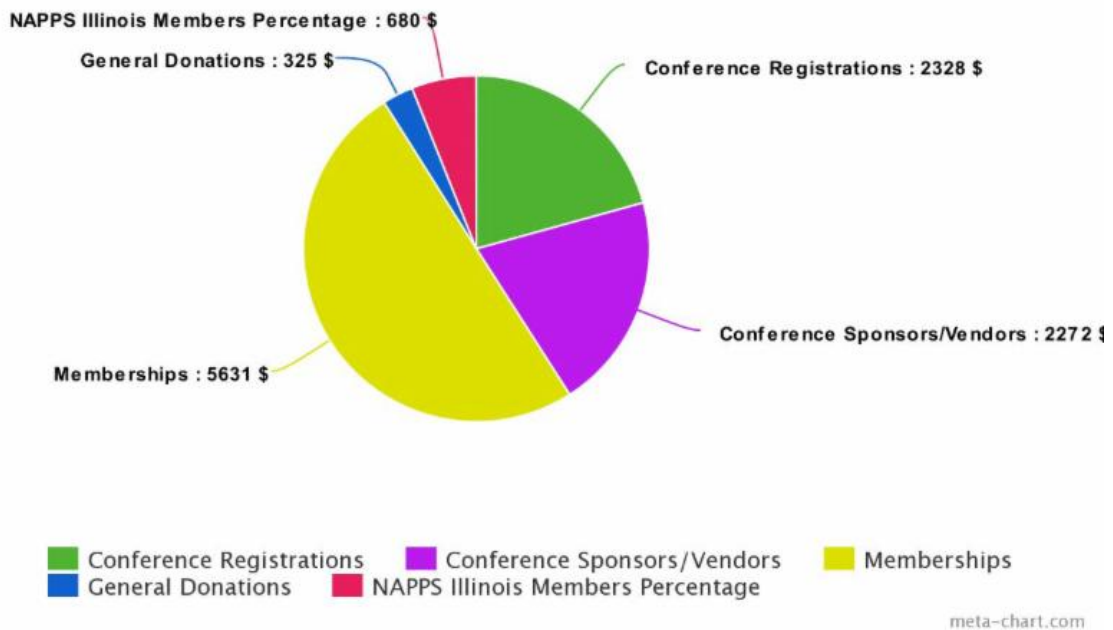
2017 ILAPPS Expenditures
